LASCNA Treasurer's Report

04/02/17

Hello Louisville Area Service Committee NA Members,

I have the March Bank Statement, Reconciliation Report, Check Register, Home Group Donation Report and all other information with me today. As of April 01, 2017, we have a current balance of \$16,428.44 in our bank account. We have four outstanding checks that have not yet cleared. Check # 2771 (Bardstown Rd. Presbyterian Church), #2773 (Highland Vineyard Church), #2774 (KRSCNA), #2776 (Ernie's Print Shop) for a total amount of \$421.39. Deducting these checks from our account balance leaves us with \$16007.05 when we take away our \$5000.00 prudent reserve; we actually have \$11007.05 in expendable income to conduct business. All of our normal bills for the month of March have been paid. I have included the invoice for February's printing of the minutes, as I received this invoice after area last month. In March, we wrote checks totaling \$4,514.39. We deposited \$1,206.57.

The final audit for LACNA 27 checking account has not yet occurred as I have not received the final bank statement or been able to review the checkbook. I contacted the LACNA 27 Treasurer last month but she was not willing to bring the information requested to the Executive Committee and stated that all of the information had been given to the LACNA 27 Chairperson. I have spoken with the LACNA 27 chairperson today and she is going to work on getting this information to me on or before the next Area meeting. The first audit of LACNA 28 will occur this afternoon at the Executive Committee and I will include this information in next month's treasurer's report.


