Chair Report Feb 2025

First, I apologize for the area minutes being mailed out two days late. I did not send them to the printer in time, and the holiday further delayed the process.

I updated the Roll Call Form for 2025 and created it in Excel to make it easier to maintain and edit. I also updated the sign-in sheet and distribution list within the same form.

Last month, we had 25 homegroups present on Zoom, with 19 providing sign-in information in the chat. Additionally, 11 groups requested printed minutes via chat. I cross-referenced all homegroups that provided information with the most recent distribution list from Michael and added the 11 additional homegroups to the printed mail list. RCM Report:

Good Afternoon family,

Our regional meeting was on January 19th, 2025 at the New Albany Token Club. The regions banks' balance is at \$28,767.88 and does not reflect Motion 1124-2 that was the motion for \$5000 we already voted on to give to the WSO. We are still waiting on votes from some Area Group. Some Regions only meet every other month and that is what is holding it up.

The Region Chair is still having troubles getting our Regions Liability Insurance due to some problems from the insurance company. He is going to go by the insurance company the week following the Regional Meeting we just had.

The Regional Delegate stated that the conference Agenda Report has 12 items on it, but they are all House Keeping items such as budgets. There isn't anything in it that is big changes. All of the 12 items in the C.A.R. are at NA.ORG. If you go under Service resources and then go to the World Service Conference. The form for Home Groups to fill out is at the same site under "Interim World Service Conference 2025 Motion List". The RD and RDA are not putting on a C.A.R. Workshop this year. If Home groups want to vote they need to turn it in to the RD by 2/15/25. The RD's email address Mugsoap@Yahoo.com. On February 28th to March 1st is a virtual conference for the RD's and RDA's and they will take the info the Home Groups sent in to set the Agenda for the May 26th Conference.

The KRCNA38 Chair had a report and said they are on track. The Flyer is attached to this report. A couple Regions did fund raisers and pulled in around \$2500 total between the two. Mark S. had mentioned our Louisville area should do a fund raiser in early April and he is going to coordinate with the new Activities Chair to see what can be done.

The other Areas are doing well. There was a motion from OVANA and OVANA is asking Region for \$500 to add to their H&I budget. They currently have \$33 a month for their budget and have 9 weekly meetings going into hospitals and institutions. A typical literature order is \$69.00. They are asking Region because OVANA can't increase the H&I budget. H&I budget was cut last year to balance the Area's budget. They stated this money would last for 2 years. The motion is attached in my report.

Angel R was voted in to be the KRCNA39 Chair. She is ready to move forward quickly since they are running behind schedule. Angel is going to get with Mark S. to get the bank account set up so they can get to work.

Today I am turning in the bank statements and other financial statements (i.e. square and cash app). Unfortunately, I will not be able to submit a check to the area because there are still a couple of small transactions that need to be approved. The balance of the bank account at this time is \$11,159.44.

I was not able to take inventory of the LACNA storage due to working 12 to 14 hours for 20 days. I am willing to go with the LACNA 35 chair to inventory the storage at her convenience if she wishes, as I am passing on the key to her today.

Again, we want to thank the Louisville Area for braving the weather and coming out to celebrate recovery with us. We couldn't have done it without you. As we move forward, we want to wish LACNA 35 all the success possible and offer any assistance they need.

The intent of this motion is to provide clarity and eliminate redundancy in quorum policies.

Simplifying the definition of quorum in the glossary establishes a single reference point, ensuring consistency and making future updates easier if requirements change.

The section on determining quorum, which was adjusted during COVID-19 to allow Area business to proceed despite reduced attendance, is now being updated for clarity and to reflect post-COVID conditions. This ensures a reasonable representation of the Area is present to establish a group conscience.
